Under this agreement for 2022  
Eight Mile Plains State School will receive

**\$122,940\***

## This funding will be used to

### Target

- Improve the percentage of students receiving a C or higher in English by the end of 2022 to 85%.
- Improve the percentage of students receiving an A or B in English by the end of 2022 to 45%.

### Measures

- Develop and utilise an A-E English tracking document to be used and monitored across the year.
- Track A-E achievement data and distance travelled in Collaborative Curriculum. Conversations.
- Year 3 and Year 5 NAPLAN reading and Writing data.
- Early Start Data (Prep-Year 2).

### Comparison

- English: Percentage A-C making relative gain.
- English: A-C with that of Similar Queensland State Schools.
- NAPLAN: Year 3 -Year 5 Reading and Writing relative gain (2020-2022).

### Monitoring

- Formative assessment used to monitor progress and plan for next steps in learning through weekly Collaborative Curriculum Conversations with Curriculum/Inclusion Leaders.
- Increase in staff knowledge, skills and understanding of the Australian Curriculum and the demands of literacy skills – reading and writing.
- Teacher planning focused on differentiated teaching and learning of reading and writing aligned to the Australian Curriculum to meet individual student needs.

## Our initiatives include

- Developing teacher capability in knowing and using the Australian Curriculum to plan for individual student need.
- Developing efficient and effective measures to collect evidence of learning which guide and inform the Teaching and Learning cycle.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing staff to support with providing curriculum release time to enhance educational programs and curriculum alignment for all students. \$48,440

Employing additional staff to provide early intervention to targeted groups of student (including additional Speech-Language Pathologist assistance). \$24,500

Providing quality professional development and capability building for staff in relation to their pedagogical practice. \$50,000
